

# **2021 AMA Extreme Championship Supplements**

The 2021 AMA Racing rulebook and these Supplemental Rules will govern these events. **Revised 5/11/2021: Updated West Schedule** 

## SERIES CLASSES:

1. The following are the classes in which Extreme Championship points will be accumulated:

Pro	(12yrs and up)	98cc and Up
Pro Women	(12yrs and up)	98cc and Up
А	(12yrs and up)	98cc and Up
В	(12yrs and up)	98cc and Up
C	(12yrs and up)	98cc and Up
Women	(12yrs and up)	98cc and Up
45+	(45yrs and up)	98cc and Up

- 2. It is the rider's responsibility to enter the proper class. You must enter the class in which you race in both AMA or non-AMA off-road events. Failure to do so will result in the loss of all points earned.
- 3. Once a rider enters and earns points towards the Pro class, they must enter Pro for the rest of the season.
- 4. Motorcycles must have a minimum wheel size of 16" rear / 19" front and a minimum wheel base of 51".
- 5. Trials bikes are not eligible for championship points.

#### **RACE PROCEDURE:**

- 1. All events shall announce their official distance, number of laps or number of checks to be considered a finisher a minimum of 1 hour before the start of the event.
- 2. The event will be run in a format that produces overall results including all riders by the end of the event.
- 3. Both rider and machine must make it to official scoring checkpoint to have distance recorded. No towing allowed.
- 4. The first rider to complete the designated distance will receive the checkered flag and their exact time (to the nearest second) of finish shall be recorded. In order to be considered a finisher; a rider must start the event and be recorded through at least one scoring checkpoint.

5. Scoring shall be based on total elapsed time (from time of rider start to final time recorded) and total scoring checks completed.

#### PROGRAM:

1. At each event, all series classes must be run. At the promoter's option, additional support classes may be run. No combination of mini-cycle, ATV or motorcycle may be run.

## START PROCEDURE:

- 1. Starting procedures will be explained at riders meeting.
- 2. Riders, pit crewmembers, machines and equipment are not permitted on the starting line until authorized by the race official.
- 3. Riders shall line up on their assigned starting row on a first come basis when directed by the race official.
- 5. All starts will be dead engine.

## **CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES POINTS:**

1. In order to be eligible for series points, a rider must finish in the top 20 of the class. Series class points will be based on the following points schedule:

# CHAMPIONS:

- 1. There will be two individual regional championships East and West with one East vs West round paying point for both championships.
- 2. All Class champions will be decided by 1 less than the total number of the events in their individual series. Points will not be combined.
  - a. Overall class numbers will be decided by 1 less than all events in both series combined.
- 3. To be eligible for series awards, a rider must compete in a minimum of 3 events of the individual serie series.
- 4. Each round of the series will qualify riders for the AMA Extreme Off-Road Grand Championship, the Tennessee Knockout. AMA supplemental regulations for qualifying will apply.

2021 Numbering System:

- 1. The 2021 overall numbering will be based on results from the 2020 East racing season. Top 10 overall Pro and Top 3 overall in each class my run their earned number if they are racing the same class.
- 2. Temporary numbers will be given at all events. Riders who are wishing to run annual numbers will submit official request.
- 3. 2021 championship numbers will be based on overall participation in both East and West Extreme Championships.



# International Riders Covid Safety Plan:

- Anyone traveling from outside the United States will be required to have a negative COVID-19 PCR test within 72 hours of departing for the Untied States. Note that current CDC rules require each air passenger to provide a negative COVID 19 PCR test no more than 3 days before their flight departs in order to board the flight. Upon arrival, any international traveler will comply with the following CDC post-travel recommendations:
  - a. All persons traveling from outside the USA must present proof of negative test and comply with CDC quarantine guidelines below. Persons must present quarantine plan to MotoAmerica
  - b. Get tested3-5 days after travel AND stay home and self-quarantine for 7 days after travel.
  - c. Even if you test negative, stay home and self-quarantine for the full 7 days.
  - d. If your test is positive, isolate yourself to protect others from getting infected.
  - e. If you don't get tested, it's required to stay home and self-quarantine for 10 days after travel.
  - f. Avoid being around people who are at increased risk for severe illness for 14 days, whether you get tested or not.
  - g. Always follow state and local recommendations or requirements related to travel.
