



2022 AMA Extreme Off-road Grand Championship Supplemental Rules

The 2022 AMA Racing Rulebook, these supplemental rules and the individual event supplemental rules will govern these events.

AMA US Hard Enduro, Extreme Off-Road Regional Championship Events:

Each AMA **US Hard Enduro**, Extreme Off-Road Regional Championship Event in addition to the Regional championship final standings, will serve as a qualifier for the AMA Extreme Off-Road Grand Championship – the Tennessee Knockout Extreme Enduro.

1. Qualifying positions are earned at each of the **Eight (8)** AMA **US Hard Enduro**, Extreme Off-Road Regional Championship Events that precede the Grand Championship:

March 23 – Page, AZ
Grinding Stone Hard Enduro – Rock Stars MC

June 10 – Donner, CA
Donner Hard Enduro – Garrahan Off-Road Training

May 1 – Billings, MT
Betonite Brawl – Billings MC

June 16/17 – Kellogg, ID
Silver Kings Hard Enduro – Inside Enduro

May 21/22 – Spragueville, IA
Iowan Hard Enduro

July 2/3 - Tamaqua, PA
Tough Like RORR – Reading Off-Road Riders

May 28/29 – Little Hocking, OH

2. Riders failing to qualify through the AMA Extreme Off-Road Regional Championship Events will have one final chance to qualify in TKO 1¹ at the Tennessee Knockout Amateur Event.

Race Procedures:

1. Each event will be part of the East and West regional championship and will have supplemental regulations in regard to formatting and class structures.
2. Riders will be eligible for the “Pro class” either through on site qualifying or previous year’s results and national series qualifications.
3. All other rules in the AMA Rulebook under Off-Road 2.9 Extreme Off-Road Meets will be followed.
4. Riders must have personal health insurance to participate in Regional Championship Extreme Off-Road Meets.



Extreme Off-Road Grand Championship Qualifying:

The following riders will qualify for the AMA Extreme Off-Road Grand Championship:

1. **Pre-Qualified PRO event riders based on AMA National Championships, World Extreme Events and past TKO results.**
 - a. **The top 50 amateur finishers from the 2021 TKO will be qualified directly to TKO 2³.**
2. Pro – The top 3 riders overall at each AMA **US Hard Enduro**, Regional Championship series event, including pre-qualified riders, will be qualified directly into the Tennessee Knockout PRO event².
 - a. **The Top 3 Pro riders at each AMA US Hard Enduro, Regional Championship Event, who are not pre-qualified into the Tennessee Knockout PRO event, will be qualified directly to TKO 2³ at the Tennessee Knock Out Amateur Event. Row assignments will be based on Friday TKO Prologue⁴ Qualifying**
 - b. **Champions – The Top 10 in the Pro class at the end of their respective East and West championship will qualify for those respective classes directly into the Tennessee Knockout PRO event².**
3. Amateur – The **Top 5 A** riders overall at each AMA **US Hard Enduro**, Regional Championship Event, who are not pre-qualified into the Tennessee Knockout PRO event, will be qualified directly to TKO 2³ at the Tennessee Knock Out Amateur Event. Row assignments will be based on Friday TKO Prologue⁴ Qualifying.
 - a. **Champions – The top 3 riders in the A, B, C, and 45+ at the end of their respective East and West championship will qualify for those respective classes directly to TKO 2³ at the Tennessee Knock Out Amateur Event. Row assignments will be based on Friday TKO Prologue⁴ Qualifying.**
4. TKO1 Qualifiers – The top 125 riders in TKO 1 to finish within the allotted time will qualify to the remaining rows of TKO 2.
5. Amateur qualifying riders will pay full entry into the Tennessee Knockout Amateur Event by August 9, 2022.
6. If a rider declines his qualifying position, or qualifies for a better starting position, there will be no back-up or replacement riders to fill the position. Riders qualifying through TKO 1 will fill the position based on finish result.

1. TKO 1: The first of three Rounds at the Tennessee Knockout Amateur Event the Saturday prior to the Tennessee Knockout Pro Event on Sunday.
2. Tennessee Knockout announces pre-qualified PRO event riders based on AMA National Championships, World Extreme Events and past TKO results.
3. TKO 2: The second of three Rounds at the Tennessee Knockout Amateur Event the Saturday prior to the Tennessee Knockout Pro Event on Sunday.
4. Friday TKO Prologue: Qualifying held Friday August 13th 2022 for all Amateur TKO Participants to determine their start order for their first race on Saturday. Those who do not participate in the Prologue will be placed based on pre-entry date.
