**A minimum of five (5) riders per class are required to receive AMA points. Classes with more than five (5) riders and less than ten (10) riders receive points at 50% of the chart value.**

## **LICENSE TYPE QUALIFICATION STANDARDS**

### **SUPREBIKE and SUPERBIKE CUP Licenses**

- Successfully completed at least two (2) racing seasons (including at least 12 race weekends) as an Expert riding a motorcycle(s) eligible for AMA MotoAmerica Superbike or Supersport competition. In this case, riders must provide documented experience on a motorcycle eligible for AMA MotoAmerica Superbike or Superstock 1000 competition.
- Earned at least 200 Expert points within a maximum of five (5) years. (Age specific classes and endurance events do not count toward rider eligibility.)

### **STOCK 1000 Licenses**

- Successfully completed at least one (1) racing seasons (including at least 6 race weekends) as an Expert riding a motorcycle(s) eligible for AMA MotoAmerica Stock 1000 competition.
- Earned at least 100 Expert points within a maximum of five (5) years, riding a motorcycle(s) eligible for AMA MotoAmerica Stock 1000 competition.

### **SUPERSPORT and SUPERSPORT DAYTONA Licenses**

- Successfully completed at least one (1) racing seasons (including at least 6 race weekends) as an Expert riding a motorcycle(s) eligible for AMA MotoAmerica Supersport or Superbike competition.
- Earned at least 100 Expert points within a maximum of five (5) years, riding a motorcycle(s) eligible for AMA MotoAmerica Supersport or Superbike competition.

### **TWINS CUP Licenses**

- Successfully completed at least one (1) racing seasons (including at least 6 race weekends) as an Expert riding a motorcycle(s) eligible for AMA MotoAmerica Superbike, Supersport or Twins competition.

### **JUNIOR CUP and SUPER HOOLIGANS Licenses**

- Must provide a copy of their current license issued by a recognized road race organization, and show demonstrated race experience. Applicants with an expert license issued by a recognized road race organization will not be required to show demonstrated race experience.

### **MINI CUP Licenses**

- Successfully complete at least one three (3) weekends experience on a 110cc, a 125cc, a 160cc or 190cc machine. Experience on a larger displacement machine will be considered equivalent.

### **KING OF THE BAGGERS Licenses**

- Must provide a copy of their current expert license issued by a recognized road race organization and show demonstrated race experience.

### **BUILD TRAIN RACE Licenses**

- Must provide a copy of their current license issued by a recognized road race organization or show demonstrated race or track experience.
