



USA Trial des Nations Team Selection Procedure



A Letter of Intent (LOI) is required from each rider who wishes to qualify for the USA Trial des Nations (TdN) Team. The LOI must be received by the AMA prior to the first AMA/NATC National of the season.

The riders who earn a qualified position on the team to represent the United States in the TdN will be contacted by the Team Manager the week following the first AMA/NATC National of the season. To be officially accepted as a member of the team, the rider must agree and sign a TdN rider contract within (1) week of receiving the contract. The team will be announced within (2) weeks following the first AMA/NATC National of the season.

The teams will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Men's Trophy Team – 3 riders selected by the AMA TdN Advisory Committee.
- Women's World Trophy Team – 3 riders selected by the AMA TdN Advisory Committee.
- Challenge des Nations Team – 2 riders selected by the AMA TdN Advisory Committee.

If applicable:

- Trial Vintage Trophy Team

Riders will be selected by the AMA TdN Advisory Committee based on national or international standings for similar type competition, and/or prior TdN experience. Any or all of these conditions will be considered for team placement. If a rider declines, their replacement will be selected from the overall results next best American finisher in the NATC series.
